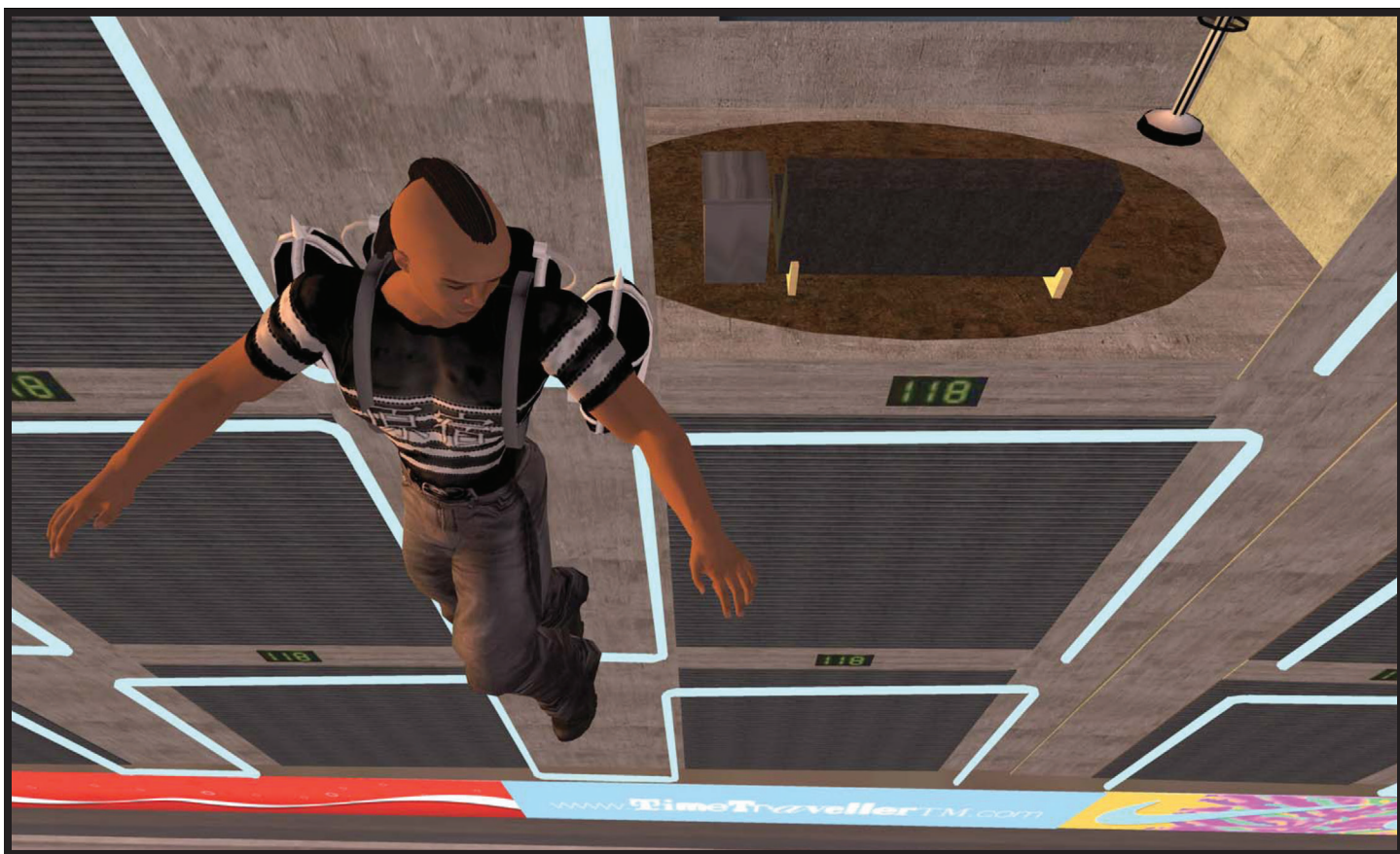


Graduate Students Needed!

The **Initiative for Indigenous Futures (IIF)** is a research project developing alternative visions of Indigenous communities tomorrow in order to better understand where we need to go today.

IIF is run by **Aboriginal Territories in Cyberspace (AbTeC)**, a network of academics, artists and technologists whose goal is to define and share conceptual and practical tools that will allow us to create new, Aboriginally-determined territories within the web-pages, online games, and virtual environments that we call cyberspace.

IIF is a multi-faceted effort including game development and modding workshops, residencies for artists and others to explore the Indigenous Future Imaginary, and an archive to capture the important work already produced by Indigenous

creators exploring the future.
